

PA Classics Letter of Commitment 2011 - 2012 Season

Parents, we appreciate your interest in PA Classics AC and hope that your son or daughter has a successful tryout. We are very proud of the success that PA Classics has had in developing all players involved within the club over the past 7 years. We look forward to bringing new families into our club for the 2011-2012 season as well as continuing to serve our existing members.

PA Classics is designed to give all players the best opportunity to reach their potential as a soccer player. We do this by providing the most experienced coaching staff in Central PA, utilizing great training and playing facilities, implementing US Soccer's best practices for player development, and by providing truly quality events for all ages at our complex. Our events bring in top clubs from Eastern PA and out of state, along with 100's of college coaches for older ages. We are also pleased to announce that as of April 1, 2011 we have opened a new turf field to further improve the clubs training and playing facilities beyond those at Classics Soccer Park.

Please read this document in its entirety so that you do not miss any important information about logistics of the upcoming year.

Upon receiving notification that your son or daughter has been selected to play for a PA Classics team during the 2011-2012 season, each player needs to mail in the last two (2) pages from this document with a \$240 deposit that is applied to next year's fees. This \$240 deposit is what secures your place on the roster. \$200 of this deposit is non-refundable. \$40 is refundable based on event support participation. Please see the "Event Support" section below for more details.

Tournaments

By July 15, 2011 your team will be a general outline of your yearly tournament schedule for the 2011-2012 season. These are the tournaments that your team will most likely be attending. Players are expected to attend every event unless you have a prior commitment, an injury, a player is sick, or an unforeseen event happens. By giving you the events this far in advance, each family should have ample time to plan accordingly. Traditionally, U9-U12 teams stay local for most events, U13-U14 team's start doing a little bit of traveling for tournaments and U15 and older will attend multiple out of town events all of which depend on the level of team.

Event Support

Pa Classics hosts numerous tournaments that are beneficial to all involved with the club. To do this, we need help from parents with the normal work that goes along with production of these tournaments. In the coming year we will be asking each family to work at one (1) tournament for one (1) shift of three (3) hours. If you have two children in the club then we will be asking for a total of six (6) hours. No one will be asked to work more than six (6) hours. If a family does not want to work the three (3) or six (6) hour time block then a \$40 fee will be assessed (per child) so that we can adequately fill your spot. If you cannot work on your teams scheduled event, then you can ask to be assigned another event that better fits your schedule. That request needs to be directed to Mike Henning via email at mikehenning@paclassics.org, and well in advance of the scheduled event. If your family would prefer not to work at any tournaments this year you may simply "buy out" of the event support operations. For 2011-2012 we have built the \$40 "buy out" of

event support into your club fees for the year, and it is paid for with the \$240 “commitment payment”. Once your family has completed the three (3) or six (6) hour event support time slot we will reduce your next scheduled payment by \$40. If you have opted not to work an event throughout the year then your yearly schedule will remain at the listed totals.

- I will be available for one (1) three (3) hour block of work at my teams scheduled weekend. Should something arise where I cannot attend I will contact Mike Henning via email at least 3 weeks in advance of the event to be rescheduled to an alternate weekend, or request to be placed on the “buy out” list. My e-mail address to contact me when hours are being assigned is;

- I will **not** be available to participate in the event support for 2011-2012 and request to be simply listed on the “buy out” list. I understand that my yearly club payments will **NOT** be reduced by \$40 because I am opting to “buy out” of event support this year.
